- 7:00 pm Amendments to Section 4.1 Floodplain District of the Auburn Zoning Bylaw to incorporate updated standards and Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) to ensure compliance as a participating national Flood Insurance Program community.
- 7:05 pm Amendments to Section 7 Signs and Advertising Devices of the Auburn Zoning Bylaw. Proposed changes include amendments to the definitions, the size of certain signs, and colors flashing lights on an electric sign.
